Principal's Message

We are now into our fourth week back at school and so much has been happening in the school. At our School Dedication Mass and our first Assembly, our Year 8 children were allocated their leadership roles for the coming year and our new Year 3-8 Class Councillors were announced. We look forward to working with these young leaders throughout the coming year.

Last week we had a successful Parent Information Evening focussed on how the school and parents can ensure your children's safety online. I really liked that, when using Family Wise, parents can turn off internet access to their children overnight so they can't use their device and enabling them to have a good sleep. This is something you might like to consider in your home.

On Tuesday we held our school swimming sports at Jubilee Pools. This is the first opportunity our student leaders have had to show their leadership skills in their newly appointed roles. It was great to see the children's House spirit as they competed and participated in events. Chanel House won the House Relay competition and our overall winning House will be announced at our prize-giving at the end of the year. Thank you to all the parents who supported this event.

Yesterday, Father Bonny and Seminarian Mark led our Ash Wednesday liturgy, prepared by Te Ropu Piripono, in our school hall. As we begin Lent we are reminded by the liturgical colour, purple, that we need to get ready and be prepared for the Holy Week/Easter; the foundation of our faith. For children, Lent is a time to go without something, such as less screen time, do something willingly for someone else, and to remember to pray by themselves.

Information regarding the payment of Attendance Dues and contributions collected for the Catholic Diocese and the St Joseph's Development Trust has been sent to you separately this week. These funds are collected on behalf of these identities and do not stay in our school account. These payments sit outside the MOE Donation scheme which will cover most student activities this year. You will continue to be asked to contribute to selected individual activities which do not involve the whole class/school.

We have also sent out a parent pledge page for all families to complete and return in regards to our upcoming school Fun Fair on Saturday 14 March. Please consider supporting the Fair in some practical way. The funds raised come back into the school and will be used on the development of the school grounds. We are hoping to surface the grassed area between the swimming pool and classrooms.

A reminder that we can provide a "KickStart Breakfast" to any child that needs this. Mrs Irwin organises this in Te Ropu Aroha and we have some wonderful parent volunteers in our hall kitchen from 8:10 am in the mornings. Any child who requires breakfast for whatever reason can go to get breakfast before school. Children cannot learn if they are hungry.

I look forward to seeing you all at our school assisted parish Mass at 10 am this Sunday.
