Hopefully, you all received the COVID-19 Level 1 letter sent out earlier in the week. In it, I stated that we are pleased to be back to "almost" normal at school. It is great to have our children back. All children, unless sick, should now be coming to school every day. The gates will be open from 8:00 am in the mornings and we encourage parents to let their children continue to walk to class independently in the mornings as we noted improved self-management skills and independence through our COVID drop off and pick up procedures. Tomorrow will be our last day the Junior Gate will be opened.

On Monday the contractors will be on-site preparing the ground for the start of our new building project. You won't see many changes at first but when their fencing goes up, this will define the area to the school we can or cannot access.
